Later in the week, campers will take a trip to Mactaquac beach and family members are invited for fun under the sun! Campers will enjoy a performance of indigenous dance and music. Making dream-catchers and other indigenous crafts will keep the campers entertained all week long!

## Week 4- July 16<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>: Ubuntu/Togetherness

For week four we will be celebrating **Ubuntu** which means togetherness. We will be taking you for a trip around Africa to explore this diverse continent and its various cultures! Campers will enjoy a fun safari scavenger hunt and participate in live African drumming sessions from our dynamic guests (campers will feel the energy as they come together throughout this week!) Also, the New Brunswick African Association's youth group Making Africa Proud will teach campers amazing African dance styles and a lot more! Campers will enjoy learning new vocabulary from a multitude of languages in Africa. Also, we have a trip planned to the Charlotte Street Art Centre for a tour and African themed arts and crafts!!
